Included with this review is a PDF listing the results of each requirement for Anonymouth. Their beta demonstration showed a significant lack of major functionality that is key to the success of the project. Out of 109 requirements, 62 were incomplete. The requirements that were fulfilled dealt mainly with the interface of the project and appeared to work without bugs. The requirements that were met did not deviate from their original description. There was one exception to this; some buttons described in the requirements as a red 'x' were actually buttons labeled with 'remove'. However, these differences did not seem major and their described functionality was consistent.
